

Familiarise yourself with the following and be ready in the event of an incident.

Pre-Flight

- ☐ Save key contact details on your phone/inReach/SPOT/Satellite phone.
- ☐ EFB charged, updated (charts/AIP, waypoints), paper-based as required.
- ☐ Fire extinguisher, axe, first aid kit and beacon (ELT or PLB).
- ☐ Appropriate clothing and equipment for the environment.
- ☐ Device (ELT/PLB/SOS) registered and contact details up to date.

Inflight Incident Response

- ☐ Transponder 7700 and push “ident”
- ☐ ELT/PLB ON
- ☐ Make **Emergency Call** as applicable (PAN/MAYDAY).

On Ground Incident Response

- ☐ Alert emergency services (if deemed appropriate) immediately.
- ☐ Check ELT transmitting on 121.5MHz.
- ☐ Do not turn off unless told to do so by RCCNZ
- ☐ If in doubt, turn on additional PLB/ELT.
- ☐ Approach aircraft, check for sources of danger: fire, leaking fuel, electrical.
- ☐ Access occupants and prepare the area for rescue services.
- ☐ **Call 111**, or contact **RCCNZ 0508 472 269, +64 4 577 8030** or **rccnz@maritimenz.govt.nz**
- ☐ All non-accident response aircraft should either remain on the ground or vacate the area.

Post Response

- ☐ Leave accident site intact after extraction of person/s, secure as required
- ☐ Report to CAA 0508 ACCIDENT (0508 222 433)
- ☐ Report to AOPA
- ☐ Support affected parties, assess fitness to fly back and carriage of extra passengers as applicable. If in doubt, utilise emergency services.

Do Not

- Respond to media, refer to Police
- Post/distribute photos of an incident
